Secondary Transfer and Reception Places

If you have a child in Year 6 please make sure you have completed your child's Secondary transfer form online by the 31st October 2017.

If you require a reception place for your child in September 2018 you must complete a form by 15th January 2017. NB: Even if your child currently attends our Nursery they will not automatically be given a place unless you complete the form. You can apply online at www.cornwall.gov.uk/admissions. Your child will have brought home a leaflet about this earlier this term.

Breakfast Club & Afterschool Childcare Bookings

A polite reminder to parents that bookings should be made in advance for breakfast and after school club childcare. The school needs to be informed no later than 3.30p.m the day before a place is required. As the clubs are getting quite busy so spaces are limited it is vitally important that we know numbers so there is the right level of adult supervision and the right amount of breakfast or snack available. Our terms and conditions are available on the school website along with our booking form.

We do understand that there are occasional emergencies and we will obviously support families if and when these unforeseen situations arise. If less than 24 hours notice is given to cancel a booked place parents will still be charged. Many thanks for your support with this matter.

CSIA Cross-Country Qualifier

Wednesday 4th October 2017

The first competitive race of the school year and the weather was kind: dry with a hint of sunshine. Perfect for running. We had a strong team of 12 runners, some experienced at this level and two debutants, Chris and Yasmin .

The course consisted of a flat route around the rugby pitches and a final descent and ascent just before the finish. The year 4 children had to race over 800m, the year 5's 1000m and the year 6 children a mammoth distance of 1800m. Very daunting.

In the year 4 race we were represented by Dexter, Chris, Max, Jacob and Jess.

All of the children ran brilliantly in a very competitive field.

Aalayah and Yasmin ran the year 5 race with an added loop to the course. However, this did not phase the girls one bit with Aalayah coming $1^{\rm st}$ by over 100m and Yasmin coming in the top 15. The boys had a high standard to match and they did not disappoint with Jack coming in $7^{\rm th}$ and Kai hot on his heels in $8^{\rm th}$.

The year 6 race increased the distance even further but Kira tackled that without trouble finishing in the top 15. George and Klevi followed in the boys race and showed fantastic determination in a strong field. George demonstrated his desire by sprinting in to $3^{\rm rd}$ place in the final 20m.

Children who finished in the top eight for their age groups qualified for the next round to be held later in the year. We will be represented by the following qualifiers: Aalayah, Jack, Kai and George.



Dear Parents/Carers,

Information and Guidance on Term Time Holidays from the Department of Education

The previous regulations (2006) allowed head teachers to grant leave of absence for the purposes of a family holiday during term time in "special circumstances" of up to ten school days leave per year.

However, as from the 1st September 2013 this has now changed. The new DFE statutory guidance states that head teachers may not grant any time off for holidays during term time unless there are <u>exceptional circumstances</u>.

Please note that the Local Authority can issue a Penalty Notice for unauthorised leave or absence of 5 consecutive days (10 sessions). It is VERY important that the school is notified of any absence at the start of the school day as any absence taken without informing the school as to the reason why, will result in an unauthorised absence.

If a parent takes their child out of school without an agreed leave of absence then the absence will have to be recorded as unauthorised which may be subject to a Penalty Notice fine by the Local Authority of £60 per child. This fine will increase to £120 if not paid within 21 days. Failure to pay the fine within 28 days may lead to court proceedings.

If you do require any absence from school a request form is available from the school office. This request will be looked at but in no way does the completion of the form guarantee the request. The request can only be agreed for exceptional circumstances.

We understand that it is often difficult for parents to take children on holiday during the allotted holiday periods due to financial implications or their work commitments. However this is a change in the law and applies to all schools so it is no longer at the discretion of individual head teachers.
