We do understand that there are occasional emergencies and we will obviously support families if and when these unforeseen situations arise.

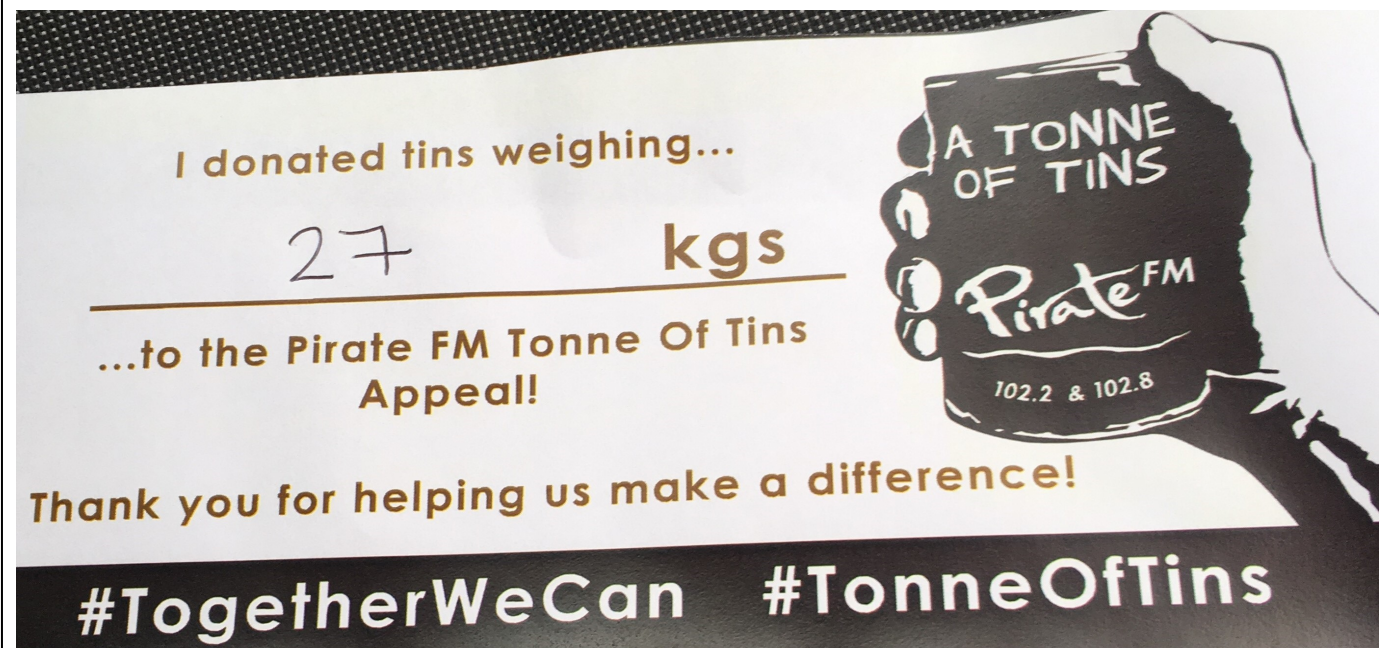
If less than 24 hours notice is given to cancel a booked place, parents will still be charged. Also we ask all parents to sign their children out so there will be a charge for any late pick ups,

Dear Parents/Carers

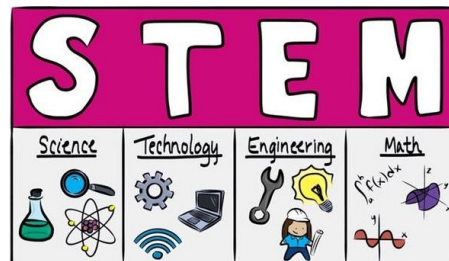
