#### Resources and activities I could do at home to help me with my learning

Make your own Home-Made clay and practice rolling, pressing and cutting it.



#### Home-Made Cornflour Clay Playdough Recipe

**You will need:**  
2 cups cornflour  
1 cup white glue

#### Method

1. Mix the cornflour and glue together until a dough is formed.
2. If the dough is sticky to touch, add more cornflour. If the dough is too firm, add a small amount of glue.
3. Make models using the clay or roll it out and use cookie or playdough cutters to make ornaments. You may need to dust the rolling pin with cornflour before rolling out your clay.
4. Air-dry overnight or place in an oven on the lowest temperature, below 100°C for 1-2 hours depending on the thickness of the clay.
