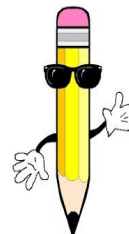

Peninsula Cross-country Finals at Pool Academy

On Tuesday we had 6 children who had qualified for the Peninsula finals from the previous event, Kayleb, Cally, Isla, Jimmy, Taiya-Mai and Aalayah. The year 4 race was run over 800m, the year 5 over 1200m and the year 6 race over 1600m. This year the children needed to finish in the top 15 of their respective races, to qualify for the Cornwall County finals in Newquay. Every children ran amazingly well in large and very competitive fields and should be extremely proud of themselves. Special mention must go to Isla, who finished just outside of the top 15 to miss out on qualification by only 2 places.
