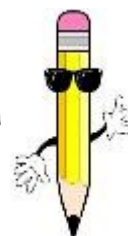

She ran an amazing race in a large field of athletes to finish in an amazing 3rd place, for the whole of Cornwall. Aalayah was awarded her bronze medal for her third place finish but also a gold medal for finishing 1st out of all of the year 6 girls from the Peninsula schools. 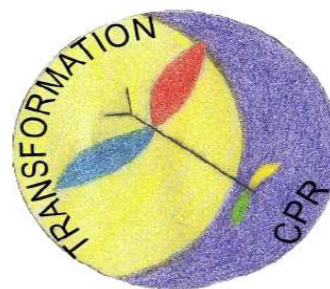
