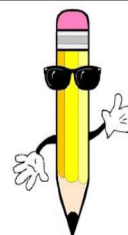

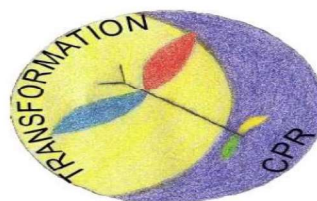






### Troon School Bowling Team
